2006 AAMP Annual Achievement Award

Lodi, WI – July 20, 2006 – Jim Peterson received a recognition at this year's Annual AMMP Conference that symbolizes what Steve Krut, AAMPs Executive Director, states as the highest appreciation to members of the American Association of Meat Processors.

During AAMPs general session, Peterson was awarded the 2006 AAMP Annual Achievement Award. As a plant owner for 25 years at Lodi Locker and teacher, Peterson was inducted into the Cured Meats Hall of Fame in 1992 for his efforts in cured meat products excellence. Soon after his accomplishments as a plant owner, Peterson went into the supplier field as a technical sales associate at ALKAR.

Peterson has served decades on the Board of the Wisconsin Association of Meat Processors and, in 1997, AAMP chose Jim to receive the F.W. Witt Supplier of the Year Award. Jim has served as an Operator Director on the AAMP board from 1983-85, and served as a Supplier Director from 1997-2000 and 2003-2006. In 1991 and in 1998, Peterson earned the AAMP Golden Cleaver Trophy for the recruiting of the most members in both years. Then Peterson was awarded again in 1997 with the Outstanding Service Award, which recognized his service of over 30 years on the Wisconsin Meat Processors Association Board of Directors and his years of service to other state and regional organizations.

With his supporting and loving wife, Mary Peterson, by his side, Jim Peterson, of ALKAR-RapidPak, was the proud and surprised recipient of the 2006 AAMP Annual Achievement Award.
